Additionally, members can access a summary of their accounts by clicking on the Pay Now Button on the Make a Payment page. 


URECC will be closed Monday, December 25, 2023, Christmas Day. We will return to regular business hours on Tuesday, December 26, 2023

Grinch OREO Truffles

Ingredients:

RECIPE

- REGULAR OREOS WHIPPED /2 CUP WHIPPED CREAM CHEESE SPREAD 2 OUNCES (1/2 24-DUNCE) PACKAGE VANILLA ALMOND BARK GREEN GEL FOOD
- OLORING ED
- RTS/SPRINKLES



Instructions:

- CRUSH OREOS INTO CRUMBS. CRUSH OREOS INTO CRUMBS. MIX OREO CRUMBS AND CREAM CHEESE SPREAD UNTIL THICK MIXTURE FORMS. SCOOP MIXTURE INTO BALLS USING A COOKIE SCOOP AND PLACE ON BAKING SHEET LINED WITH PARCHMENT PAPER. REFRIGERATE FOR 30 MINUTES. MELT ALMOND BARK IN A MICROWAYABLE BOWL FOR 1 MINUTE STIR THEN CONTINUE TO MICROWAYE 15-20 SECONDS UNTIL MELTED.
- ONDS UNTIL MELTED. TRUFFLE BALLS ONE BY ONE INTO THE ELTED ALMOND BARK UNTIL FULLY
- ACE ONTO PARCHMENT PAPER AND PLACE A CANDY HEART OR SPRINKLES WHILE COATING IS STILL SOFT. REFRIGERATE FOR AN ADDITIONAL 30
- MINUTES UNTIL COATING IS FULLY HARDENED.
